



## ***Course Offerings and Credits***

### **Professional Water Damage and Restoration Series**

#### **1. Using Industry Standards and Guidelines [Course Code: PWD609]**

This course module overviews the science behind drying wet buildings and what to watch out for—including a brief summary of how to make sense out of “mold damage”. We will review and provide a side-by-side comparison of current water damage standards and guidelines and their implications in today’s restoration world. We will discuss the differences between accreditations and one-day-training courses and the merits of getting accredited, or why to make sure you hire professionals who are.

#### **2. Clearance Testing (Post Remediation Assessments) [Course Code: PWD809]**

This course module overviews the global exposure guidelines to fungi and bacteria indoors and their relevancy to the process of “clearance testing” (or *Post-Remediation Assessments (PRAs)*). We will review the PRA process, how and when PRAs can help, and we’ll discuss how to define “when cleaning is complete” for contractors. We will discuss the “ifs, whens, wheres, whys, and hows” of microbial sampling, and how to correctly interpret the results. The course will finish with a discussion on who should be performing the post-remediation assessment and why.
